It is obviously a well-established format and I hope parents enjoyed the opportunity to see the children in sporting mode. Unfortunately we were not able to hold our Early Years and KS1 sports events as it rained for the rest of our Health and Fitness Week. However, parents will be pleased to know that the children did not miss out as we managed to squeeze in their sporting activities at the beginning of this week.



A huge thank you to everyone for making the Summer Fair the success that it was. Firstly thank you to the sun for shining down on us all afternoon which meant we were able to run all of our fabulous stalls. Thank you to children for all your efforts in baking and making special things to sell. Children, staff and our fabulous parent volunteers helped to set up the fair which made it feel even more like a whole community event. And of course, thank you to family and friends for collecting your children for the afternoon and enjoying the fair. I have had so much positive feedback and we raised £1577 for school and Mr Carter's year 5 class raised £500 for the Trinity Holistic Centre who support those affected by cancer across Teesside.

End of year outcomes

We are thrilled with the statutory test and teacher assessment outcomes (*unvalidated*) for 2017,

which in all cases are well above last year's national averages and in almost all cases represent an improvement on school results 2016. We are particularly pleased that the strategies we have put in place to improve standards in maths have worked, especially in year 6 where maths outcomes have improved by 17% (from 72% to 89%). Well done to all our children and staff for their hard work, commitment and well-deserved success. And a huge thank you to our parents/carers for your continued support and involvement in your children's academic success.

End of Reception Good Level of Development (GLD) – the percentage of children reaching the expected level of development: **83%** (an increase of 4% on our 2016 result and above the 2016 national average of 69%)

Y1 Phonics: 91% (not quite as high as last year's 96% but still in the 90's and well above 2016 national of 81%)

Y2 Phonics retakes: 100% of children who didn't pass the phonics screening last year, passed it this year.
