



YEAR 6 VISITS TO ROBINWOOD 21st -23rd May 2018

Dear Parents / Carers,

We will soon be heading to Robinwood for three days of fun and adventure. Below are the last arrangements that you need to be aware of.

Departure time

Please bring your child to the doors at the back of the hall for 7.30 a.m. You are welcome to wait in the hall with your child. When you arrive please can you get your child to register with their class teacher. Also at this point any children with medication will need to hand their plastic wallet (see below) to Mrs Coverdale. Then the children will have an opportunity to visit the toilet, as we will not be stopping en-route (unless there is an emergency).

At approximately 7.45 we will ask parent/carers to leave the hall and take your child's luggage to the coach, it doesn't matter which coach your child's luggage is placed on. While you do this we will tell the children which group they are in and which coach they will be travelling on. We will then make our way to the coach. We will be leaving school at approximately 8.15. The coach ride is approx 2 hours.

PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE LAYBY ON WINDMILL WAY AS THIS IS WHERE THE COACH WILL PARK AND YOU WILL BE ASKED TO MOVE YOUR CAR. THIS ALSO APPLIES WHEN WE RETURN.
