Y6 Visit to Beamish Museum / Monday 15th October 2018

We have planned a visit to Beamish Museum on Monday 15th October in connection with our Y6 Victorian topic. This is an award-winning museum with many interesting exhibits and artefacts relating to this period of study and provides the children with a valuable opportunity to experience life as a Victorian child, including a lesson set in a Victorian classroom led by a 'School Master'.

As part of the day's events, the children (and adults!) will be asked to come in Victorian dress :

For boys - flat-caps, waistcoats and a shirt and trousers will be enough.

For girls - a shawl and mop-cap with long skirt and blouse will suffice.

Please do not go to any unnecessary expense!

The children will leave at **8.45 am** and return to school at approximately **5.00 pm**. We will be outdoors for most of the day so the children will need warm waterproof clothing and sensible shoes.

Please indicate if your child has a school meal and they will be provided with a school packed lunch on this day.

We request from parents/guardians a voluntary contribution of £7.65 per child to contribute towards the entry fee, coach hire and use of the school room and artefacts. This cost has been significantly subsidised by school funds, due to the rising cost of hiring coaches as a result of high fuel prices. Please return the consent slip below and return this, along with payment, to your child's class teacher by Friday 28th September. The trip will form an integral part of the History curriculum related to the Victorians and follow-up lessons will focus on this visit.
