KS2 Progress Measures

The progress measures are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment and come in the form of scaled scores and a school progress score.

Scaled scores are reported between 80 and 120 with 100 as the national standard

Progress scores are for the school only, not individual pupils. A score of 0 means that pupils in school on average do as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally. A positive score means pupils do better. A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points
