World Book Day 2024

This year's **World Book Day** will be held on **Thursday 7th March 2024** with the theme being,

'Read Your Way'.

Year groups have planned a range of book-based activities that will take place on this day. During the afternoon, each class will visit every teacher in their team to hear staff read a variety of stories and poems to them.

All children are invited to dress up if they would like to but this is not a requirement. We would also like children from EYFS –Y6 to bring in their favourite book for the day to share with others (please ensure your child's name is in it). A WBD voucher will be sent home with each child, these are redeemable from **Thursday 15th February until Sunday 31st March 2024** at the following retailers: Asda, Sainsbury's, Tesco, Waterstones, The Works and WH Smiths along with any independent bookshop.

Top tips for putting together a costume:

- *Start with things you might already have – tracksuits, t-shirts (inside out to make them plain) and pyjamas make a good base for a costume.*
- *Focus on the parts of the character that make them stand out - use face paint or simple props to show these.*
- *Try a costume that invites recommendations – a t-shirt with post-it notes on for example.*
- *Keep it simple with a character who wears everyday clothes, by focussing on a prop, or by using a badge instead or add small details to focus on key elements of the character – hats, ears, sticking things on t-shirts etc.*
