**Year 4 Visit to Whitby
Wednesday 18th June 2025**

We are excited to let you know that we have planned a visit to Whitby as part of our Year 4 Geography topic this term. The children have been learning about human and physical geographical features, and this trip will give them the chance to compare what they know about Ingleby Barwick with what they can see and experience in Whitby. It's a fantastic opportunity to explore a real coastal town rich in geographical features.

The trip will take place on Wednesday 18th June 2025.

No trip to the seaside would be complete without a traditional lunch from the chip shop! We are asking for a contribution of £6.50 towards the cost of the meal. School will cover the cost of transport.

The restaurant can cater for vegetarian options and food allergies—we will be checking children's preferences in advance to ensure every child's needs are met and they feel included. If your child would prefer, they are welcome to bring a packed lunch instead.

Please be aware, all chips are cooked in beef dripping and each meal comes with a small drink.

Please choose from the following options:

1. Vegetarian option – halloumi burger and chips
2. Fish and chips
3. Chicken nuggets and chips
4. Sausage and chips

Payment as usual is via Arbor in advance, so that the chip shop can prepare our order.

We will leave school promptly at 9.00 am and aim to return by approximately 3.30 pm. Further updates and reminders will be shared nearer the time. This is a little later than normal school finish. We will keep you informed of any further time delays due to traffic. We realise this may have an impact at school pick up but we wanted the children to have the maximum amount of time to explore Whitby.

Children will need to bring a water bottle and a backpack as they will need somewhere to put their clipboard to make notes throughout the day. All children will need to dress appropriately for the weather, including a waterproof coat as they will be outdoors. School uniform should be worn with comfortable footwear. (Trainers will be fine).

We're really looking forward to what promises to be a fun, active, and educational day by the sea.
