

Exciting News: Introducing 'The Clubhouse' – A New Chapter for Wrap Around Care at IMPS



Dear Parents and Carers,

We are absolutely delighted to share some fantastic news about an exciting new chapter for wrap around care at Ingleby Mill Primary School. From September 2026, our much-loved Plus 5's provision will be brought fully in-house becoming a vibrant and valued part of the IMPS family. This is a significant step forward for our school, allowing us to create a seamless, high-quality experience for children that truly reflects our ethos from the very start to the very end of the day. We are especially pleased to share that Michele will continue to lead the provision, ensuring the same familiar, nurturing care your children already know and love, now further strengthened and enriched through the support, vision and consistency of the wider school team.

In true IMPS spirit, we asked the children who currently attend wrap around what this exciting new chapter should be called, and put their thoughts to a whole school vote - we are thrilled to share that they have chosen the name *The Clubhouse* - a place full of warmth, friendship, fun and belonging. As we bring The Clubhouse to life, we are investing time, care and creativity to ensure it is something truly special. We are currently reviewing and upgrading our equipment and resources, designing engaging activities for all children, and developing delicious menus which will be available to view on our school website. Alongside this, there will be a simple one-page school-home agreement to support our shared expectations and ensure the very best experience for all.

To make booking as smooth and straightforward as possible, all sessions will now be managed through Arbor, where you will be able to book and pay for provision. Payment will be required at the point of booking, and we kindly ask that you note places cannot be confirmed without payment in advance. The timings and costs for The Clubhouse are as follows:

- **Before School (Reception to Year 6)**
 - 7:15–7:45am: £3.50
 - 7:45–8:30am: Free DfE Breakfast Club
- **Before School (Nursery)**
 - 7:15–8:30am: £5.00
 - 7:45–8:30am: £2.50
- **After School (All Children)**
 - 3:15–6:00pm: £12.00
 - 4:40–6:00pm: £7.00(*for children attending after-school clubs; not available in the final week of each full term*)

We are pleased to confirm that we will accept childcare voucher schemes, including Tax-Free Childcare, for payment of Clubhouse sessions. If you wish to use this payment method, you must contact the school office by email before making a booking and provide your child's name. This is because we need to complete the necessary setup on Arbor to enable childcare voucher payments for your account. Once this has been completed, you will be able to book sessions using this payment method.

When registering with a childcare voucher provider or the Government's Tax-Free Childcare portal, you may be asked for the school's details:

We kindly ask that parents allow sufficient time for this setup process before making bookings to ensure sessions can be secured without delay.

We are pleased to confirm that holiday provision will continue to be run by Plus 5s as a separate service to the school. Parents wishing to book holiday club sessions should continue to do so directly with Plus 5s through their usual booking process.

As we shape The Clubhouse, your voice is incredibly important to us. We would be so grateful if you could take a few moments to scan the QR code and complete our short survey, indicating your interest and sharing your thoughts to help us design a provision that absolutely meets the needs of our families.

The booking system will go live on Wednesday 8th July 2026, allowing us time to ensure everything is running smoothly and ready for a seamless start in September.

We are genuinely so excited about this next step and all that The Clubhouse will bring for our children - a place to play, to relax, to connect and to thrive. Thank you, as always, for your continued support as we embark on this exciting journey together.
